Keys to This Piece:



For proper balance, be sure that the melody is two dynamics louder than the accompaniment, whether it be in the LH tenor voice or the top note of a RH chord.



Keep arms loose for a flowing RH accompaniment and for when the RH has full chordal melodies.



Create your own story to convey the imagery of the rising sun.
