The Appalachian Mountains extend from Maine to Georgia. **Appalachian Folk Music** had its roots in the southern part of this region and became popular during the folk revival of the 1950s and 1960s. It developed from the stories of English ballads, as well as from Irish and Scottish fiddle music, religious music, and African-American blues. The fiddle, banjo, dulcimer, and guitar were the instruments used most frequently.
