



Alberti Bass Accompaniment

The Alberti bass is a LH accompaniment pattern often used in music from the Classical period (1750–1820). It is named after Domenico Alberti (1710–1740), an Italian composer.

In an Alberti bass, the notes of a chord are played in this order:

* A *sonatina* is a short sonata. *Sonata* is an Italian word that was first used as the title for any piece played by a musical instrument and not sung.
