Early jazz, often known as **New Orleans Jazz**, had its beginning in that city in the early 1900s. Its traditions grew from band music performed for street parades and funeral processions. New Orleans musicians, including trumpeter Louis Armstrong and pianist Jelly Roll Morton, helped spread jazz to other parts of the country and, eventually, around the world.
