GPS stands for Global Positioning System, a satellite-based tracking system made up of satellites placed in orbit by the U. S. Department of Defense. These satellites fly about 12,000 miles above the earth at approximately 7,000 miles per hour. GPS originally was developed as a defense system by the military, but is now available to the public and is most often used to aid with navigation. GPS systems are often found in cars and on cell phones.
