



**Hark! the Herald Angels Sing** is one of over 6,000 hymns written by Charles Wesley. The words were not used with the music of Felix Mendelssohn until over 100 years after they were written. William H. Cummings, an English musician, combined the words with a theme from the second movement of a Mendelssohn cantata.
